GIRISH AGNIHOTRI, J. (Oral)

The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of lockdown due to outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

Petitioners-Balwinder Singh and two others, have jointly filed the present petition *inter alia* with a prayer for issuance of directions to the respondents to put up the case of the petitioners before the Duty Judge and to pass an appropriate order in the anticipatory bail application (Annexure P-2) filed by the petitioners in FIR No.237 dated 05.09.2020, registered under Sections 306/34 of Indian Penal Code at Police Station B-Division, Amritsar as the concerned learned Judge is on leave as he has been found to be corona positive.

On the last date of hearing, this Court passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the concerned Judge before whom the case is pending will now

hold Court from tomorrow. Thus, the case is likely to be taken up for hearing either tomorrow or day after tomorrow.

Adjourned to 06.11.2020.”

Today, during resumed hearing of the case, at the outset learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the present petition has become infructuous as the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Amritsar, has already been taken up the matter for hearing.

In view of the above, no further orders are called for in the present petition and the same is disposed of as having become infructuous.
