Present petition has been filed by the petitioner with a prayer that the petitioner had executed certain works on contract basis for which he is yet to be released the admissible payments.

As per the petitioner, the works done/executed by the petitioner have been completed to the satisfaction of the respondents but the payments are not being released to the petitioner and that too without any valid justification.

As per the averments made in paragraph 10 of the petition, the petitioner has already raised the said grievance with the authority by serving a legal notice dated 09.07.2020, copy of which has been attached as Annexure P-3 and as per the averments, the same is still pending consideration with the authority.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Deipa Singh, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, who has joined the proceedings through video conference, keeping in view the service of advance copy of petition, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and submits that respondent No.2 will decide the legal notice dated 09.07.2020 (Annexure P-3) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by him in the legal notice dated 09.07.2020 (Annexure P-3), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the legal notice dated 09.07.2020 (Annexure P-3) within a period of three months from the receipt of copy of this order.

In case, it is found that the petitioner is entitled for any payments, the same should also be released to the petitioner within three months thereafter.
