The petitioners pray for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 0099 dated 24.06.2020, registered under Sections 323, 341, 506, 148, 149 IPC (Sections 325 and 307 IPC added later) at Police Station Sadar Kharar, District SAS Nagar.

The operative part of the order dated 03.11.2020, vide which interim anticipatory bail has been granted to the petitioners, is reproduced as under:-

“...Counsel for the petitioner has relied upon order dated 21.9.2020 passed in CRM-M-25194-2020 vide which co-accused-Gurjant Singh @ Gonu and Gurpreet Singh @ Rangeela were granted the concession of anticipatory bail as they have volunteered paid Rs.20,000/- compensation without prejudice to their right of defence.

CASE HEARD THROUGH VIDEO CONFERENCING

Counsel for the petitioners has submitted that, in pursuance to the order dated 03.11.2020, the petitioners have appeared before the Investigating Officer and have joined the investigation and also handed over the demand draft of Rs.20,000/- favouring the complainant to the Investigating Officer.

Counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Karamvir Singh, has not disputed the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioners are no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 03.11.2020 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
