Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Through this petition, the petitioners seek anticipatory bail in case FIR No.268 dated 27.11.2019, registered at Police Station City Moga, District Moga, under Sections 336, 427, 148, 149 and 307(added subsequently) of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, 1959.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that vide order dated 20.02.2020 passed in CRM-M-53316-2019 and 53320-2019 by this Court, the petitioners had been granted anticipatory bail under all the above-noted sections except 307 IPC, which has been added at the time of presentation of challan. Moreover, there was no fire-arm injury in the present case.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of this Court, Mr. M.S.Nagra, AAG, Punjab,

accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and does not dispute the aforesaid submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioners.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

Challan has already been presented. The petitioner is not required for further investigation or interrogation and he is only to face the trial.

In view of the above, however without going into the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioners to appear before the trial Court within 15 days from today. On their doing so, the petitioners shall be released on bail by the trial Court to its satisfaction. However, it is made clear that in case the petitioners fail to appear before the trial Court within the stipulated period, this petition shall be treated as dismissed.
