1. Learned counsel for the parties states that as per instructions from the petitioner and respondent No.2 respectively, it had been decided to mutually settle the dispute as is the subject matter of the writ petition on the petitioner making lumpsum payment of ₹4,00,000/- in full and final settlement of all claims of respondent No2 vis-à-vis her termination from service vide order Annexure P-10 dated 09.09.2013.

2. In view of amicable settlement having been arrived at amongst the parties, the writ petition is allowed. Impugned order Annexure P-1 dated 29.01.2014 is set aside subject to the petitioner making payment of ₹4,00,000/- to respondent No.2 within four weeks from date of receipt of certified copy of order and intimation of bank account number and bank details of respondent No.2 to the petitioner. Aforesaid payment shall be in full and final settlement of all claims of respondent No.2 vis-à-vis termination order Annexure P-10 dated 09.09.2013.

3. However, it is made clear that in case payment of ₹4,00,000/- is not made to respondent No.2 within the stipulated period of time, the same shall carry interest @ 7.5% per annum w.e.f. date of termination till date of payment.
4. Writ petition disposed of in the aforementioned terms.
