This case has been taken up through Video Conferencing via Webex facility in the light of Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Petitioner seeks benefit of regular bail pending trial in FIR No.271 dated 12.08.2020 under Section 15 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Chandimandir Police District Panchkula.

Counsel for the parties have been heard.

Petitioner was arrested on 12.08.2020 and as per prosecution version the alleged recovery effected is of 2 kgs. poppy husk.

Investigation in the case is complete and the challan stands presented. Charges are yet to be framed in the present case.

Trial as such would take time to conclude. The alleged recovery in the present case would be construed as non-commercial.

It has gone uncontroverted that the petitioner is not involved in any

other case under the NDPS Act.

In view of the above, petitioner is held entitled to the benefit of bail.

Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Panchkula.
