All cases listed today have been taken up for hearing by way of video conferencing because of the situation existing due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

This petition has been filed under the provisions of Section 439 of the Cr.P.C. seeking 'regular bail' for the petitioner in case FIR no. 155 dated 28.11.2019, registered at Police Station Majitha Road, Amritsar, for the alleged commission of offences punishable under Sections 420/120-B of the IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in fact the matter has been compromised with the complainant, with Mr. Sandeep Wadhawan, learned counsel appearing for the complainant, not denying the same.

There being no other criminal case registered against the petitioner, even as per the instructions of the learned State counsel (as per the custody certificate), without making any comment on the actual merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioner shall be admitted to bail upon his

furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
