Present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to consider the claim of the petitioners for the post of Lab Technician in the National Health Mission.

At the outset, instead of pressing the petition on merits, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he would be satisfied in case representations dated 15.02.2020 (P-8 Colly) are decided by the competent authority, expeditiously.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Kiran Pal Singh, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and he is not averse for the innocuous prayer made by the petitioners.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without going into the merits of the case, this Court deems it appropriate to dispose

off the present petition with a direction to respondent No.2- The Mission Director, National Health Mission, Panchkula, to consider and decide representations dated 15.02.2020, if the same are pending, by passing speaking order in accordance with law, within a period of 4 weeks' from today.
