The matter is taken up for hearing through video conference due to COVID-19 situation.

The present petition is filed for seeking regular bail in FIR No.121 dated 27.08.2020 under Sections 22, 29 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (Sections 61, 85 added later) registered at Police Station Makhu, District Ferozepur.

The basic ground for seeking appeal is the delay in receipt of FSL report. The learned State counsel submits that the FIR is of last week of August, 2020. There is no inordinate delay rather all efforts are being made to ensure that the report is received in time so that challan can be presented.

Considering the date of the FIR and the intervening period, the present petition is dismissed at this stage. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to revive the prayer in case there is further unnecessary delay in receiving the FSL report.
