The present petition has been filed by petitioner-Gurwinder Singh, *inter alia*, with the prayer to quash the impugned order dated 09.03.2016 (Annexure P-3) whereby the claim of the petitioner for promotion has been rejected.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the grievance of the petitioner is that the respondents were duty bound to consider the case of the petitioner for promotion as Head Constable and also for grant of notional promotion w.e.f. due date and also consequential benefits.

In this case, notice of motion was issued on 21.11.2016.

Upon notice, Sh. Sundeep Singh Mand, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police (Head Quarter) Kapurthala, has filed reply on behalf of the respondents No.1 & 4. In the said reply dated 20.02.2020, it has been stated that the matter for granting promotion to the petitioner is under process. The petitioner has however been considered and promoted as Head Constable. A copy of the order passed by the Deputy Inspector General of Police, Jalandhar Range, Jalandhar, promoting the petitioner as Head Constable has

been filed in Court which is taken on record.

In this view of the matter, no further orders are called for.

The petitioner is however at liberty to make any grievance for the relief that still remains to be granted to him and also has liberty to file a fresh writ petition claiming the reliefs not granted by the respondents.
