The matter has been taken up through video conferencing on account of lockdown due to outbreak of COVID-19 pandemic.

The petitioner Tinku aged 25 years has filed the present petition *inter alia* with a prayer directing the respondents No.2 to 4 to immediately take action against illegal encroachments over the land belonging to Provincial govt. in village Kila Phillaur.

Record shows that on 03.11.2020, this Court had directed the counsel for the respondent-State to seek instructions. Today on the resumed hearing of the case, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance to the said order dated 03.11.2020 passed by this Court, a demarcation was conducted and a report in this regard has been submitted by Naib Tehsildar Phillaur to Deputy Commissioner as well as respondent No.3.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner with same/similar grievance had submitted a representation on 10.06.2020 to both the above mentioned authorities but till date no decision has been taken.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and without commenting upon the merits of the case, this Court deems it appropriate to dispose of the writ petition by directing the competent authority to consider and decide the petitioner's claim as raised in his representation dated 10.06.2020 and subsequent reminder, as early as possible and take appropriate action as is required in accordance with law within 2 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
