CWP-18322-2020

Present petition has been filed by the petitioner with the grievance that the petitioner has not been given five marks for which he is entitled under the heading "Socio-Economic Criteria".

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in case the said marks would have been given to the petitioner, he would have got selected for the post of Clerk in the reserved category of Scheduled Caste, as advertised by the respondent on 20.06.2019.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance with the respondent-Haryana Staff Selection Commission vide his representation dated 05.11.2020 (Annexure P-17) which is still pending consideration with the said authority and the petitioner will be satisfied in case, a time bound direction is issued to the respondent to decide the said representation by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Ms. Deipa Singh, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, who has joined the proceedings through video conference, keeping in view the service of advance copy of petition, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent.

Learned counsel for the respondent does not raise any objection for deciding the representation dated 05.11.2020 (Annexure P-17) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by him in the representation dated 05.11.2020 (Annexure P-17), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent to decide the representation dated 05.11.2020 (Annexure P-17) within a period of four weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.
