Prayer in the petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for the issuance of a writ of Mandamus for directing the respondents to grant the benefit of five years service towards pensionary benefits in terms of statutory provisions of applicable law and also as allowed by this Court in similar matter i.e. CWP No.6595 of 2017, vide decision Annexure P/4 dated 02.04.2019 which has been upheld upto Hon'ble the Supreme Court.

Learned counsel states that the petitioner has submitted a representation, Annexure P/6 dated 18.02.2020, in respect of the grievance which is the subject matter of the present writ petition, but the same has not been decided till date. The petitioner would be satisfied if the writ petition is disposed of, at this stage, by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation Annexure P/6 dated 18.02.2020, in accordance with law, in a time bound manner.

Accordingly, without commenting upon the merits of the controversy or the entitlement of the petitioner to the relief claimed, the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation Annexure P/6 dated 18.02.2020, in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible, preferably within eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. In case, the petitioner is found entitled to the relief claimed, then the benefits in respect thereto; as per entitlement; be released within a period of four weeks thereafter.
