Learned counsel for the petitioners very fairly states that the relief claimed by the petitioners in the present writ petition with regard to counting of their previous services, which was specifically denied to them vide order dated 24.05.2011 (Annexure P-7), stands granted to them. He, therefore, states that the relief of the petitioners qua this has attained finality. He prays for liberty to the petitioners to file a representation with regard to the regularization of the period of break in their services, which had accrued earlier because of the wrongful termination of their service.
