The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.66 dated 22.03.2018, under Sections 302, 307, 120-B, 379-B, 109, 216 and 34 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Baroda, District Sonapat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is not named in the FIR wherein 10 persons have been named out of whom 02 have been attributed gun shot injuries to the deceased. The petitioner was arraigned as an accused on the statement of co-accused namely Sunil that the petitioner was also present in one of the vehicles along with co-accused. He is in custody for almost 02 years since his arrest on 04.12.2018.

Learned State counsel states that the petitioner is also involved in several cases. He upon instructions states that although the charges have been framed but none of the prosecution witnesses have been examined.

Heard through video conferencing.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner, especially when the petitioner is not named in the FIR wherein 10 persons have been named out of whom 02 have been attributed gun shot injuries, he has been arraigned as an accused on the statement of co-accused, he is in custody for almost 02 years, Covid 19 pandemic and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.

However, the petitioner shall appear before the Police Station Baroda, District Sonapat on every alternate Monday till the conclusion of the trial.
