1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.

2. Prayer in the petition under Section 12 read with Section 14 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, is for initiation of action against the respondents for flouting order Annexure P/1 dated 14.10.2020 in CWP No. 17072 of 2020.

3. Learned counsel contends that vide order dated 14.10.2020, while issuing notice of motion in CWP No. 17072 of 2020, operation of order dated 07.10.2020, Annexure P/16 in the writ petition, was stayed but the respondents had violated order dated 14.10.2020, by not allowing the petitioners to continue at their initial place of posting.

4. Learned DAG, Haryana, on the other hand, has placed copy of order dated 07.10.2020, on record and states that order Annexure P/16 bearing No.1861 dated 07.10.2020, was withdrawn by the respondents

circumstances, the Contempt Petition does not call for any further orders and may be disposed of as such. Aforesaid order is taken on record, copy supplied to learned counsel for the petitioners, who on perusal thereof, states that in view of the statement of learned DAG, Haryana, as well as order bearing No.1897 dated 07.10.2020, he does not press the Contempt Petition and the same may be disposed of as such.

5. Accordingly, in the light of the statement of learned counsel for the parties, the Contempt Petition is disposed of as not pressed.
