Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have simply stood as guarantor/ surety. Krishan Kumar has been permitted to revoke the guarantee. Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that their case has not been considered by the respondent-bank on the same footing. The petitioners be permitted to file a representation before the respondent-bank and their case be considered on the analogy of Krishan Kumar.

The petitioners are permitted to make a representation within two weeks and the same shall be considered by the respondent-bank by passing a speaking/ detailed order within a period of four weeks thereafter.

Learned counsel for the respondent-bank has fairly submitted before the Court that no coercive steps are initiated against the petitioners only.

The writ petition stands disposed of.
