The affidavit dated 3.3.2020 has been filed today in the Court stating therein that the balance amount of Rs.8,90,376/- from 1.1.2006 to 31.12.2015 towards family pension arrears of 6th pay commissioner has already been released in favour of the petitioner vide pay order dated 21.2.2019.

Accordingly, the present writ petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed accordingly.

However, it is evident that earlier amount of Rs.3,20,427/- was paid on 31.5.2018 but the balance amount of Rs.8,90,376/- was paid as late as on 21.2.2019. While pointing out to the delay, the respondents palming off the responsibility on each other. The fact remains that it is definitely not on account of the fault of the petitioner.

Accordingly, the respondents are directed to pay 6% interest on the delayed amount of Rs.8,90,376/- from the date it was due i.e. 4.7.2018 till the same was paid i.e. on 21.2.2019 within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
