GIRISH AGNIHOTRI, J. (Oral)

The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of lockdown due to outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

Petitioner-Parween Kaur, stated to be aged 24 years, has filed the present petition *inter alia* with a prayer for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 & 3 to take appropriate action against respondents No.5 to 10, who are in-laws of the petitioner and are harassing her for demand of dowry.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, based on the pleadings in the petition, submits that marriage of the petitioner had taken place with respondent No.5 on 23.04.2018. It is submitted by the petitioner that on 16.09.2018, she was shunted out from her matrimonial home.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that for the

same/similar grievance as made in the petition, the petitioner had filed a representation dated 18.09.2020 (Annexure P-4) before The Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran (respondent No.3).

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Saurav Khurana, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4.

In view of the above, without commenting upon merits of the case, the present petition is **disposed of** with a direction that in case, the petitioner approaches the police authorities concerned, with above representation (Annexure P-4) or any other representation being filed before the Competent Authority concerned, the same shall be got examined by respondent No.3, as expeditiously as possible, preferably within two months from the date of receipt of copy of this order, in accordance with law and necessary steps as may be warranted under the facts and circumstances of the case, be taken thereupon forthwith.

A copy of this order be sent by the Registry to respondent No.3, through e-mail or any other mode, so as to enable the said authority to do the needful expeditiously.
