The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of lockdown due to outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

Petitioner-Nasar, stated to be aged 41 years, has filed the present petition *inter alia* with a prayer to direct respondents No.2 to 5 to adhere to the application dated 09.09.2020 (Annexure P-2) and redress the grievances of the petitioner by taking appropriate action against respondents No.5 to 19 keeping in view the guidelines as laid down by hon'ble Supreme court of India in ***Lalita Kumari vs. Government of UP and others, AIR 2014 (SC) 187*** with a further prayer to adhere to the Provisions of Chapter XII of Code of Criminal Procedure and especially the Provision of Section 154 Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, based on the pleadings in the petition, makes specific reference to Para 9 of the petition, to submit that

private respondents allegedly on 06.10.2020, attacked upon the family of the petitioner. It is then submitted that family has danger to their life and also the apprehension that they can again be attacked.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that for the same/similar grievance as made in the petition, the petitioner had filed an application dated 06.10.2020 (Annexure P-3) before The SHO, Bichhore.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Rajiv Goel, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4.

In view of the above, without commenting upon merits of the case, the present petition is **disposed of** with a direction that in case, the petitioner approaches the police authorities concerned, with above application (Annexure P-3) or any other representation/application being filed before the Competent Authority concerned, the same shall be got examined by respondent No.4, as expeditiously as possible, preferably within two months from the date of receipt of copy of this order, in accordance with law and necessary steps as may be warranted under the facts and circumstances of the case, be taken thereupon forthwith.

A copy of this order be sent by the Registry to respondent No.4, through e-mail or any other mode, so as to enable the said authority to do the needful expeditiously.

Ordered accordingly.
