1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of pandemic Covid-19.
2. Prayer in the Petition under Section 10/12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, is for initiating action against the respondents for willfully disobeying order dated 18.12.2019, in CWP No.36264 of 2019.
3. Learned counsel contends that CWP No.36264 of 2019, was disposed of vide order dated 18.12.2019, with a direction to the respondent to decide the legal notice dated 01.09.2019, within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and further that in case the petitioner was found entitled to any relief, she would not be granted arrears till the date of filing of the writ petition, but despite lapse of sufficient period of time, needful has not been done, therefore, the respondents are liable to be proceeded against under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
4. Notice to respondent No.3 to show cause as to why proceedings under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 be not initiated against him for violation of orders dated 19.12.2019, in CWP No.36264 of

5. Mr. Aditya Sharda, learned Asstt. A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.3 and on instructions from Mr. Sanjeev Gautam, District Education Officer, Hoshiarpur, has placed on record copy of order dated 16.03.2020, passed by respondent No.3 in compliance with the directions of this Court dated 18.12.2019, in CWP No.36264 of 2019. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof states that in view of the aforementioned order, he does not press the Contempt Petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

6. In view of the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the Contempt Petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
