Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.52 dated 01.06.2019 under Section 498-A IPC, registered at Police Station Bassi Pathana, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

On November 22, 2019, parties were present in the Court. They were interacted. They have shown their inclination to stay together. Accordingly, the case was adjourned for today with a direction to the petitioner that he will visit the house of the complainant to take her and join her in the matrimonial home for which the petitioner was required a rented accommodation.

Petitioner who is present in the Court states that he has hired a

rented accommodation and they are staying together in the rented

accommodation.

Learned counsel for the complainant, on instructions from the complainant, who is also present in the Court and is duly identified by her counsel, states that the complainant is staying with the petitioner and as on date, she has no grievance against him.

Heard.

Since the parties are staying together as husband and wife, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 29.07.2019 whereby arrest of the petitioner was stayed, is hereby made absolute.

The petitioner shall not be arrested and in any case he is required in this case in any manner, a clear 15 days' notice be given to him, so that he can have recourse to legal remedy.
