Case taken up through video conferencing.

Petitioner-Amarjit Singh, aged about 30 years, resident of village Chak Tare Wala, Tehsil Dharamkot, District Moga, has filed the present writ petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. craving for issuance of direction to official respondents No. 1 and 4 to enquire into the representation dated 07.09.2020 submitted by him and to take further necessary action in the matter.

According to the petitioner, on 14.08.2020 at about 05:00 AM, while he alongwith his friend Sukhwinder Singh were doing exercise in the form of running, then suddenly two motorcycles, each having three riders came there. The persons driving the motorcycles had their faces muffled. Four persons, who were known to the petitioner and belong to his village, namely, Karamjit Singh @ Babbu son of Pritam Singh, Gurdev Singh @ Babbu son of Joginder Singh, Harpreet Singh @ Laddu son of Pritam Singh

and Raju Driver attacked the petitioner causing injuries to him with their respective weapons. On intervention of Sukhwinder Singh, the assailants fled from the spot alongwith their respective weapons. Injured was shifted to hospital where he was medicolegally examined. Injury No.2 on his person was declared to be grievous. The matter was reported to the police but no action has been taken thereon.

Notice of motion.

Mr.Amit Mehta, Sr. DAG, Punjab, accepts notice and submits that any order in accordance with law may be passed by this Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to the Senior Superintendent of Police, District Moga, to look into the representation of petitioner dated 07.09.2020 (Annexure P-2) and take necessary action in the matter and the petition be disposed of.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of directing Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga, District Moga – respondent No.3 to look into the representation dated 07.09.2020 (Annexure P-2) submitted by the petitioner and thereafter, to take necessary action so warranted by the facts and circumstances of the case, in accordance with law at the earliest but not later than one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
