This case has been taken up through Video Conferencing via Webex facility in the light of Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of directions to the official respondents No.2 and 3 for taking action against private respondents No.4 and 5.

Counsel submits that a complaint dated 26.05.2020 (Annexure P-2) has been submitted to the Hon'ble Chief Minister of the State of Haryana and yet no action has been taken till date.

Counsel has been heard at length.

Perusal of the complaint at Annexure P-2 would reveal that the petitioner claims herself to be a lady and belonging to the backward class category and in order to earn livelihood she has started a book shop for selling books and stationery under the name and style of M/s Pearl Books

Campus, Rania w.e.f. 16.03.2020. It is alleged that the private respondent Sanjay Saini had published forged and fake news on the social media on 13.05.2020 just to cause damage to the reputation of the book shoop and on the basis of which a raid was conducted as regards evasion of GST.

This Court finds the complaint dated 26.05.2020 (Annexure P-2) to be utterly vague. Even the contents of the alleged forged and fake news are not disclosed in the complaint. Neither such material has been adverted to in the instant petition or appended as an Annexure. Under such circumstances no intervention in the matter is warranted.

An additional prayer made in the instant petition is for issuance of directions to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty to the petitioner from private respondents No. 4 and 5.

Pleadings on record are completely lacking insofar as any imminent danger to the life and liberty to the petitioner. No directions in this regard also can be issued.

Petition is dismissed.
