Hearing of the case was held through video conference on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

This petition, under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, has been filed for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing the official respondents to protect his life and liberty from his wife-respondent no.5.

The petitioner claims that a petition for grant of decree of divorce filed by him against respondent No.5 is pending. It is further pleaded that respondent no.5 is threatening to commit suicide while falsely implicating the petitioner. It has also been pleaded that respondent no.5 and her relatives are harassing the petitioner.

This court has heard learned counsel for the petitioner and perused the paper book.

In the considered view of this court, the petitioner has more than one equally efficacious remedies. The petitioner can very well file a civil suit for grant of injunction. He can also file a criminal complaint before the court of learned Judicial Magistrate.

In view thereof, this court does not find it appropriate to exercise the extra ordinary jurisdiction under Article 226 of the Constitution of India.

Disposed of accordingly.
