Petitioner is seeking quashing of the Corrigendum dated 20.10.2016 issued by respondent No.2/Secretary, Haryana Staff Selection Commission where the petitioner, who was selected to the post of Post Graduate Teacher(PGT) Political Science for Mewat Cadre has now been declared unselected.

On notice of this petition, a short reply has been filed on behalf of respondent No.2. As per reply after declaring the final result it came into the notice that in the result dated 16.10.2016 in General Category roll No.42900260 has been indicated inadvertantly instead of roll No.42900016. The petitioner having roll No.42900260 has got 150 marks out of 200 marks and Vinod Kumar having roll No.42900016 has got 154 marks out of 200 marks. Therefore, the respondent-Commission issued a Corrigendum dated 20.10.2016. It was a clerical mistake and this clerical mistake has been rectified by respondent-Commission.

Reference has been made to note of the final result dated 16.10.2016 (R-2/1).

"Note:- While every care has been taken in preparing the result, possibility of inadvertent errors cannot be ruled out. The Commission reserves the right to rectify the same later on."

This reply has been filed on 09.02.2018 but till date no replication has been filed by the petitioner to show that petitioner has more marks than Vinod Kumar who was higher in merit.

Keeping in view the fact that the Commission has wrongly mentioned the Roll Number of the petitioner and the fact that this mistake has now been rectified by the Commission by selecting Vinod Kumar, at this stage no ground is made out to quash the corrigendum dated 20.10.2016.

Writ petition is dismissed.
