This petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing respondent No.1 to 5, to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members from respondent No.8 and 44.

It is the pleaded case of the petitioner that the respondents on 07.05.2020, came armed with deadly arms to Village Kaamal Wala and ploughed the agriculture land. In spite of repeated complaints, no action has been taken thereon.

On a Court question, learned counsel for the petitioner has admitted that during the last six months, the petitioner has neither filed a civil suit nor filed any criminal complaint before the Magistrate.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, this Court does not find it appropriate to exercise its extraordinary jurisdiction. Hence, the petitioner is relegated to the alternative remedy.

In view thereof, the present petition stands disposed of.
