The present petition has been filed by petitioner-ASI Satish Kumar, *inter alia*, with the prayer to quash the impugned orders dated 14.05.2016 (Annexure P-2), 21.03.2017 (Annexure P-4) and also 23.04.2018 (Annexure P-5), whereby the claim of the petitioner regarding the period of dismissal from service i.e. from 14.05.2016 to 26.04.2018 had been rejected.

Notice of motion in this case was issued on 03.08.2018. On 22.08.2019, reply has been filed by Sh. Shashank Kumar Sawan, IPS, Deputy Commissioner of Police, Headquarters, Gurugram, on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4. Along with the reply, an order dated 04.06.2018 (Annexure R-1) has been attached. It has been stated by learned counsel for the respondents based on the pleadings in the reply that the suspension period of the petitioner w.e.f. 18.12.2014 to 13.05.2016 has been decided as period spent on duty for all intents and purposes vide order dated 04.06.2018. All the benefits of suspension period have already been disbursed to the petitioner. It has been submitted that as such the present writ petition is liable to be dismissed as infructuous.

In view of the above, no further orders are called for.

Writ petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
