The present criminal writ petition has been filed under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner which is in danger at the hands of the private respondents and not to interfere and let the private respondents or anybody else to interfere in her life or harass her in any manner against her wish and to her detriment by using force on her by adopting unlawful means.

Counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that the petitioner is living separately from her husband-respondent no. 4. Respondents no. 5 and 6 are the father-in-law and father of the petitioner respectively. She is maintaining a minor child and living on rent at Fatehgarh Sahib and is under threat perception of the said respondents. Representation dated 30.10.2020 (Annexure P-1) has been filed with respondent no. 2 bringing to his notice the said threat perception.

Rana Harjasdeep Singh, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents no. 1 to 3.

Keeping in view the limited relief as such claimed, the present petition is disposed of with directions to respondents no. 2 and 3 to examine the representation dated 30.10.2020 (Annexure P-1) and take appropriate steps in accordance with law.
