**ARVIND SINGH SANGWAN, J.** (Oral)

This is the first petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.265 dated 14.9.2020 under Sections 323, 379, 506, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar, District Amritsar.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that on account of a dispute of Rs.10,000/- there was a sudden fight between the parties and the FIR has been registered by giving a colour that the petitioner and co-accused have snatched some amount from the complainant. It is also stated that an FIR No.195 dated 19.9.2020 was registered against the father of the complainant, in which he has been arrested.

Counsel for the petitioner relies upon the order dated 28.10.2020 passed in CRM-M-34157-2020, whereby the co-accused Atinderpal Singh @ Honey has been granted the concession of anticipatory bail. Counsel for the petitioner submits that except Section 379 IPC, all the other offences are bailable and the petitioner is ready to join the investigation.

Learned State counsel could not dispute the fact that co-accused Atinderpal Singh @ Honey has been granted the concession of anticipatory bail. It is also not disputed that there was a money dispute between the parties and the present FIR was registered 04 days prior to the registration of the FIR No.195 dated 19.9.2020, wherein the father of the complainant was arrested.

After hearing the counsel for the parties and considering the submissions made by the counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is admitted to bail, subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

However, it will be open for the Investigating Officer to summon the petitioner by issuance a notice to him.
