Case has been heard through video conferencing in view of
COVID-19 Pandemic.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is seeking
regularisation of his services in the light of the judgment rendered by the
Coordinate Bench of this Court in CWP No.2828 of 2016 titled Surinder
Singh and others v. PSPCL and others decided on 27.7.2018.

It is further submitted that in this regard, the petitioner has
already served legal notice dated 23.4.2019 (Annexure P-14) but no action
has been taken by the respondents.

Counsel for the petitioner has further submitted that he will be
satisfied if necessary direction is given to the respondents to decide the
aforesaid legal notice in a time bound manner, as per law.

Accordingly, without expressing any opinion on the merits of

the case, this writ petition is disposed of with direction to the respondents to

consider and decide the legal notice dated 23.4.2019 (Annexure P-14) of the petitioner, in accordance with law, within next three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
