The grievance of the petitioners is that they are drawing salary lesser than their juniors. This anomaly has been corrected in respect of similarly situated persons but despite legal notice having been served, the petitioners have not been granted any relief.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Ambika Bedi, AAG Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and waives service.

Learned State counsel on instructions submits that after receipt of legal notice dated 14.03.2020 (Annexure P-2) the service record of the petitioners has been called for and is being scrutinized and that the legal notice shall be disposed of within a short time frame.

Considering the nature of the order being passed there is no necessity of filing a written statement.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 3 to decide the pending legal notice dated 14.03.2020 (Annexure P-2) in accordance with law expeditiously and in any case within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
