Matter has been taken up through Video Conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of directions to the official respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners by voicing an apprehension and threat at the hands of private respondent No.4.

Pleadings on record would make it apparent that petitioner No.1, Kuldeep Kaur is aged 39 years and is the widow of Gurcharan Singh. She has left her in-laws place and is now in a live in relationship with petitioner No.2, Gurnam Singh, aged 35 years. Gurnam Singh is also stated to be married otherwise. The two children that were born out of the wedlock between Kuldeep Kaur and Gurcharan Singh (since deceased) have been left at the mercy of the in-laws.

This Court under no circumstances can approve of such relationship/liaison.

At this stage, counsel seeks withdrawal of the petition.
