By this petition, the petitioner seeks the issuance of directions to respondents no.2 and 3 to register an FIR as per law against respondent no.4 after considering and deciding the representation dated 30.09.2020 (copy Annexure P-2), and to further conduct free and impartial investigation on that representation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been inflicted injuries by her son and daughter-in-law, i.e. respondents no.4 and 5 herein, and despite her representation to the Superintendent of Police, Ambala, on 14.10.2020 (copy Annexure P-2), no action has been taken.

This petition is consequently disposed of without making any comment on the actual merits of the allegations made, with a direction to the SP,

Ambala, to go into the matter and to take a decision thereon as per law within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
