In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police (Rural), Jalandhar, to look into and decide representation dated 08.09.2020 (Annexure P-3) in accordance with law by passing speaking order and that too within eight weeks positively from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
