This is a petition for regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. on behalf of the petitioner, in case FIR No.0036 dated 26.03.2019, under Section 22/61 of the Narcotics Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (in short 'NDPS Act') registered at Police Station Bassi Pathana, Fatehgarh Sahib.

2. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that even the co-accused Gurjit Singh, who was apprehended along with the petitioner and from whom 9 injections of Buprenorphina (BUPINE) had been recovered, has already been granted bail by the Trial Court itself.

3. The petitioner by now has remained in detention for almost 1 year. There is no record of his involvement in any other case under NDPS Act.

4. Considering the long detention undergone by the petitioner, he is ordered to be released on regular bail subject to appropriate terms and conditions to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
