On an earlier occasion, petitioner had approached this Court by filing petition (CRM-M-18936-2019) seeking quashing of the FIR in question, whereupon the following order was passed:-

“Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short 'Cr. P.C.') by the petitioner seeking quashing of FIR No.18 dated 23.02.2017, under Sections 279, 304-A of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Sadar Batala, District Gurdaspur, and order dated 19.07.2017 passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Batala.

After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission for withdrawal of the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to the petitioner to raise all the points before the learned trial Court at the appropriate stage.”

Without disclosing the factum of filing the earlier petition, second petition for quashing of the same FIR has been filed. When, confronted, counsel for the petitioner expressed regret and prays for withdrawal of the present petition.

Permitted to do so.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
