[1] Copy of order dated 10.02.2020, passed by the Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Sonapat, Haryana, has been produced by learned counsel for respondent No.4 as per which, benefit of extension of service up to age of 60 years has been granted to the petitioner and his pay has been re-fixed for extended period of 02 years w.e.f. 31.03.2011 to 31.03.2013, beside pensionary benefits have also been revised. However, as per order dated 24.10.2007 in *Civil Appeal No.5128 of 2001* in case titled as '**Union of India versus B.M. Jha**', payment of arrear of salary for the extended period of 02 years has been denied on the principle of 'No work No pay'.

[2] Copy of the order dated 10.02.2020, is taken on record. Copy thereof handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner, who states that the writ petition may be disposed of by granting the petitioner liberty to challenge order dated 10.02.2020 to the extent, it denies payment of arrears of salary.

[3] In view of the position as noted above, the writ petition is ***disposed of*** as not calling for any further orders, while granting the liberty, as prayed for.
