Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.PC for quashing the FIR No.174 dated 23.08.2020 under section 392 IPC at Police Station Sector 31 Chandigarh (Annexure P-1) in view of compromise dated 06.10.2020 (Annexure P-2) and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has failed to satisfy this Court as to how an offence, which is non-compoundable, can be compounded on the basis of compromise stated to have been effected between him and the complainant, who has been arrayed as respondent No.2.

In view of the above, no ground is made out for quashing the afore-mentioned FIR on the basis of compromise. Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed.
