As agreed, as per statements of learned counsel for the appellant as well as counsel for the Insurance Company, separately recorded, a sum of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand Only) over and above the amount already awarded by the Tribunal, is awarded to the appellant in full and final settlement of the claim. Counsel for the appellant further states that the entire enhanced amount be paid to the appellant-Neeraj Kumar S/o late Sh. Mangu Ram.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit cheque in the sum of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand Only) favouring the appellant-Neeraj Kumar S/o late Sh. Mangu Ram with the Office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 06.03.2020. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The appellant's counsel may collect the cheque/draft from the office of the Lok Adalat. The office shall retain the photocopy of the cheque/draft bearing signatures of the Counsel.

Appeal stands disposed of.
