In the present petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, the petitioners seek directions to provide protection to the life and liberty from the private respondents Nos.4 to 6, who are relatives of petitioner No.1, on account of their marriage which has taken place on 02.11.2020 as per Sikh rites and rituals at Gurudwara Akalgarh Sahib, village Karor Kalan, Tehsil & District Mohali. The marriage certificate has been appended as Annexure P-3.

The date of birth of petitioner No.1 is 09.01.2000 as per Aadhaar Card (Annexure P-1) and the date of birth of petitioner No.2 is 27.01.1997 as per Aadhaar Card (Annexure P-2). It has been averred that petitioner No.2 is agriculturist and having 14 acres of land and in a good position to bear the burden of matrimonial life.

A representation dated 02.11.2020 (Annexure P-4) has also been filed with respondent No.2 in this regard.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Rana Harjasdeep Singh, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents/State.

After hearing counsel for the petitioners, without commenting upon the validity/legality of the marriage or the age of the petitioners and in view of the binding precedent of the **Hon'ble Apex Court in Lata Singh Vs. State of U.P. and another 2006(2) SCC (Criminal) 478**, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to look into the above said representation filed by the petitioners and take appropriate action in accordance with law and provide protection, if so required.

In case, there is any material concealment about any of the facts mentioned in the petition, it will be open to any of the parties to bring the same to the notice of this Court then this order will be liable to be withdrawn.
