Petition herein is under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release the salary of the petitioner from May 2020 to till date as it is not released.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner caused issuance of a legal notice dated 19.08.2020 (Annexure P-2) but the same has not been adverted by the respondents till date. Hence, the writ petition.

3. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by any of the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

4. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority to look into the legal notice dated 19.08.2020 (Annexure P-2) and also by keeping in view the contentions stated in the present petition by treating the same as supplementary representation and decide the same by passing an appropriate order, in accordance with law.

5. Let the needful be done within a period of 6 weeks from the date of this order.
6. The writ petition stands disposed of accordingly.
