1. The present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ of mandamus for granting extension to the petitioners to service till regular appointments with a further prayer to consider the representation dated 10.07.2020 (Annexure P-6) moved by them.

2. It is submitted by the counsel for the petitioners that the petitioners and the other persons were selected in the same selection process. However, the persons who were lower in merit, as compared to the petitioners, in the process of selection, have been granted extension up to 31.05.2021. Whereas, the petitioners have not been granted extension after 31.05.2020.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Puneet Gupta, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

5. The counsel for the petitioner submits that, at this stage, the petitioners would be satisfied if their representation dated 10.07.2020 (Annexure P-6) is considered by the respondents and a conscious decision is taken thereon.

6. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the University is not averse to the consideration of the case of the petitioner, however, in accordance with law.

7. In view of the above, the respondents are directed to take a conscious decision upon the representation of the petitioners, dated 10.07.2020 (Annexure P-6), after affording opportunity of hearing to the petitioners, within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

8. Still further, it is ordered that in case the petitioners are found entitled to any relief by the respondents; then the same shall be extended to the petitioners within a further period of one month from the date of above said conscious decision.

9. The petition is disposed of with the above direction.
