Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.285 dated 16.10.2020 under Sections 467, 469, 471, 472, 417, 209, 200, 199, 193, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station City Sangrur, District Sangrur.

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was passed by this Court on 09.11.2020: -

“...Counsel for the petitioner inter alia contends that the only role attributed to the petitioner is that he being Municipal Commissioner, had attested Asha Rani as he knew her and he was not having any knowledge about her Aadhar Card number. The case is triable by the Magistrate and the petitioner is ready and

willing to join the investigation...”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Harnek Singh, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioner is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 09.11.2020 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
