Petition herein is under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to issue appointment letter to the petitioner on the post of Animal Attendant (Group-D) having been selected in the Category of Scheduled Caste along with all consequential benefits.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner submitted a representation dated 14.11.2019 (Annexure P-8) but the same has not been adverted till date by the official respondents. Hence, the petition.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner would be satisfied if the instant writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to take a final decision thereupon within a stipulated time frame.

4. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by any of the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

5. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority to objectively consider the representation dated 14.11.2019 (Annexure P-8) and also by keeping in

view the contentions in the present petition by treating the same as supplementary representation and decide the same by passing a speaking order, in accordance with law.

6. The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
