The matter has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of COVID-19.

Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.0175 dated 16.10.2020 under Sections 75, 43, 66-D of the Information Technology Act, 2000 and Section 420 IPC, registered at Cyber Crime Police Station, Gurugram, District Gurugram.

Learned counsel for the petitioner relies upon CRM-M-35810-2020(Harender Singh Versus State of Haryana) and submits that for the same set of allegations, co-accused Harender Singh has been admitted on bail by this Court vide order dated 09.11.2020. He further submits that the petitioner is in custody since 17.10.2020.

Learned State Counsel does not dispute the custody period of

the petitioner and the fact that the allegations against the petitioner are similar to that of co-accused Harender Singh, who has been admitted on bail by this Court vide order dated 09.11.2020.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Petitioner is in custody since 17.10.2020 and for the same set of allegations, co-accused Harender Singh has been admitted on bail by this Court vide order dated 09.11.2020. In view of COVID-19 pandemic, trial is not likely to be concluded in the near future. Thus, this Court deems it appropriate to admit the petitioner on bail.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is admitted on regular bail, subject to his furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
