Prayer in this 2nd petition is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.148 dated 01.10.2018 registered under Section 15 of the NDPS Act at Police Station Ding, District Sirsa.

As per the allegations in the FIR, on receiving a secret information that the petitioner is involved in the business of narcotics and if a raid is conducted, poppy husk can be recovered from his house. After following due procedure, 190 Kgs of poppy husk was recovered from the petitioner at the spot.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in custody since 01.04.2019 and the trial is not proceeding, however, it is also stated in para 11 that the petitioner is not involved in any other case.

In reply, counsel for the State has opposed the prayer for bail on the ground that the petitioner is involved in 03 more cases under the NDPS Act, 02 cases under the Excise Act and 02 more FIRs under

the IPC. It is also stated that the case is now fixed for recording the prosecution evidence.

In view of the above, counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw this petition, at this stage.
