The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of lockdown due to outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

Petitioner-Ramchander, stated to be aged 60 years, has filed the present petition *inter alia* with a prayer for directing the respondent authorities for taking action on representation dated 14.03.2020 (Annexure P-1) and/or to register an FIR under Sections 361, 420, 452, 468, 405, 506, 120-B & 34 of Indian Penal Code against respondents No.4 to 7.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that for the same/similar grievance as made in the petition, the petitioner had filed a representation dated 14.03.2020 (Annexure P-1) before The Superintendent of Police, Mini Secretariat, Panipat.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Rajiv Goel, DAG, Haryana, accepts

notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SHO Dalbir, Singh, submits that representation submitted by the petitioner has been examined and detailed report in this regard has already been prepared. This police report has also been forwarded on whatsapp group of Video conferencing, including the counsel for the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner accordingly makes an oral request that she would go through the said report and would submit a representation against the said report, within a period of two weeks from today.

In view of the above, without commenting upon merits of the case, the present petition is **disposed of** with a direction that in case, the petitioner approaches the police authorities concerned, with any representation, the same shall be got examined by respondent No.3, as expeditiously as possible, preferably within one month from today and take appropriate decision in accordance with law and necessary steps as may be warranted under the facts and circumstances of the case, be taken thereupon forthwith, within two months therefrom.

A copy of this order be sent by the Registry to respondent No.3, through e-mail or any other mode, so as to enable the said authority to do the needful expeditiously.
