By way of present civil writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India the petitioners have sought issuance of writ in the nature of *mandamus* for restraining the respondents from dispossessing the petitioner from the land in question during the pendency of the revision petition alongwith stay application dated 25.10.2020 bearing ROR No. 468 of 2020 (Annexure P-1) before the Financial Commissioner as the revision petition so filed has been adjourned for 13.01.2021 without hearing on the stay application.

Heard.

In the light of oral submissions of the two sides the present petition stands disposed off with the directions to respondent No.1 to take up the revision petition alongwith stay application pending before it and dispose off the same in accordance with law expeditiously preferably within a period of one month from the receipt of copy of this order.

Till then, no coercive means shall be taken against the property of the petitioners.
