All cases listed today have been taken up for hearing by way of video conferencing because of the situation existing due to the Covid-19 pandemic.

By this petition, the petitioners seek the concession of 'anticipatory bail' under the provisions of Section 438 Cr.P.C., upon FIR No.211, dated 14.11.2019, having been registered at Police Station Jhunir, District Mansa, alleging therein the commission of an offence punishable under Section 306 of the IPC.

Though the translated version of the suicide note has not been placed on record despite the orders dated 06.11.2020 (in CRM-M-36407-2020) and 10.11.2020 (in CRM-M-36865-2020), however a copy of the vernacular version thereof has been sent to me by the Reader of this court, which learned counsel for the petitioner (Mr.Chugh) has very fairly read out upon directions of this court.

Looking at the allegations made against the petitioners in the said suicide note, without making any comment on the actual merits of the case, I do not think its a case where the petitioners can be admitted to anticipatory bail at least.

Consequently, these petitions are dismissed.

If the petitioners are arrested, and thereafter file any application under the provisions of Section 439 Cr.P.C., naturally those petitions would be dealt with on their own merits, very expeditiously, by the competent court.
